Grades 4 - 12

RULES, INFORMATION & JUDGING CRITERIA

The Creative Writing Competition promotes literary creativity and allows students to incorporate what they have learned about the honored country of Ghana through the written word. The Creative Writing Competition entries can include any type of literary work, fictional or non-fictional, including but not limited to poems, essays, short stories, plays, narratives, scripts and biographies. First, second, and third place winners will be chosen in three grade categories (Upper Elementary - 4th & 5th grades; Junior - 6th-8th grades; Senior - 9th - 12th grades). The competition is open to students attending any public, private, or home school within the Memphis metro area. Each entry must be submitted with a completed Creative Writing Competition entry form (typed or printed only). **Entries must be received by Memphis in May no later than 5:00pm on Wednesday, March 25, 2020.**

Judging Criteria

1. Theme must pertain to Ghana.
2. All entries must be typed.
3. Length should be from one to five pages, typed, and double-spaced.
4. All entries will be judged on format, organization/structure (flow), grammar, spelling, creative thought, vivid imagery, accuracy of details, and how well they engage the reader.

Senior Division

- 1st place winner - \$200 Cash Prize
- 2nd place winner - \$100 Cash Prize
- 3rd place winner - \$50 Cash Prize

Junior Division

- 1st place winner - \$200 Cash Prize
- 2nd place winner - \$100 Cash Prize
- 3rd place winner - \$50 Cash Prize

Upper Elementary Division

- 1st place winner - \$200 Cash Prize
- 2nd place winner - \$100 Cash Prize
- 3rd place winner - \$50 Cash Prize
